



TAXI SUPER Privacy Policy

TAXI SUPER is subject to the Australian Privacy Principles pursuant to the Privacy Act 1988 as amended by the Privacy Amendment Act 2012. Our Privacy Statement describes how **TAXI SUPER protects** the privacy of your personal information.

COLLECTION

TAXI SUPER will only collect personal information which is necessary for the operation of its business. TAXI SUPER will only collect such information by lawful and fair means. At the time of registration TAXI SUPER collects personal information about an individual from the individual. If TAXI SUPER collects personal information about an individual from someone else, it will take reasonable steps to ensure that the individual is or has been made aware of the matters.

PURPOSE OF INFORMATION

TAXI SUPER will collect and use personal information to provide services to you and to administer those services. TAXI SUPER may also use information to develop new products and services, attend to your enquiries, seek feedback, or tell you about other products or services offered by TAXI SUPER. TAXI SUPER may also seek personal information for legal reasons.

INFORMATION USE AND DISCLOSURE

TAXI SUPER will not use or disclose personal information about an individual for a purpose (the secondary purpose) other than the primary purpose of collection unless:

01) TAXI SUPER reasonably believes that the use or disclosure is necessary to lessen or prevent: serious and imminent threat to an individual's life, health or safety; or serious threat to public health or public safety; or the use or disclosure is required or authorised by or under law.

02) TAXI SUPER has reason to suspect that unlawful activity has been, is being or may be engaged in, and uses or discloses the personal information as a necessary part of its investigation of the matter or in reporting its concerns to relevant persons or authorities;

03) TAXI SUPER reasonably believes that the use or disclosure is reasonably necessary for one or more of the following by or on behalf of an enforcement body:

the prevention, detection, investigation, prosecution or punishment of criminal offences, breaches of a law imposing a penalty or sanction or breaches of a prescribed law; the enforcement of laws relating to the confiscation of the proceeds of crime; the protection of the



public revenue; the prevention, detection, investigation or remedying of seriously improper conduct or prescribed conduct; the preparation for, or conduct of, proceedings before any court or tribunal, or implementation of the orders of a court or tribunal.

If TAXI SUPER uses or discloses personal information it must make a written note of the use or disclosure.

The above operates in relation to personal information that TAXI SUPER has collected from a related body corporate as if TAXI SUPER's primary purpose of collection of the information were the primary purpose for which the related body corporate collected the information.

KIND OF INFORMATION

TAXI SUPER will only seek personal information relevant to its business relationship with you.

DATA QUALITY

TAXI SUPER will take necessary and reasonable steps to make sure that the personal information it collects, uses or discloses is accurate, complete and up-to-date.

DATA SECURITY

TAXI SUPER will take necessary and reasonable steps to protect the personal information it holds from misuse and loss and from unauthorised access.

TAXI SUPER will take necessary and reasonable steps to destroy permanently personal information if it is no longer needed for any purpose for which the information may be used under Australian Privacy Principles.

TAXI SUPER is not likely to disclose personal information to overseas recipients.

OPENNESS

On request by a person, TAXI SUPER will take necessary and reasonable steps to let the person know what sort of personal information it holds, for what purposes, and how it collects, holds, uses and discloses that information.



ACCESS AND CORRECTION

If TAXI SUPER holds personal information about an individual, it will provide the individual with access to the information on request by the individual.

If TAXI SUPER holds personal information about an individual and the individual is able to establish that the information is not accurate, complete and up-to-date,

TAXI SUPER will take reasonable steps to correct the information so that it is accurate, complete and up-to-date.

ANONYMITY

Wherever it is lawful and practicable, individuals will have the option of not identifying themselves when entering into transactions with TAXI SUPER.

SENSITIVE INFORMATION

TAXI SUPER will not collect sensitive information about an individual unless:

- a. the individual has consented or
- b. the collection is required by law

COMPLAINTS

If you believe that TAXI SUPER has not complied with its obligations concerning your personal information, you should contact TAXI SUPER and lodge a complaint. TAXI SUPER will investigate your complaint and attempt to resolve any breach that may have occurred in relation to the collection, use or destruction of your personal information held by TAXI SUPER in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 and related legislation.

If you are not satisfied with the outcome of the investigation, you can lodge a privacy complaint by contacting the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner.
